Launched in autumn 2022, the international project "Wer ist Walter? Resistance against Nazism in Europe" has been the occasion for an international team of historians, curators and other researchers to discuss and work on history and memories of resistance against Nazism, fascism, occupation and collaboration during World War II, especially in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, France and Germany. We realized this project in order to develop mutual knowledge, to strengthen the inclusion of the (post-)Yugoslav space in discussions about European history and memories, and to support Trans-European networks in the field historiography, museums and historical-political education. During the concluding event of the project in Sarajevo we will present the outputs we have developed together: a scientific publication, an educational digital platform and an exhibition at the History Museum of Bosnia and Herzegovina. At this occasion, we will also discuss together the current and future role of museums, education and historical research in working on the topic of resistance during World War II, and continue our common exploration of memory sites linked to this history.
